MIMOS, KAD sign MoA to develop new tech for healthcare industry

KUALA LUMPUR: MIMOS, the national research and development centre in ICT and Kontron Asia Pacific Design (KAD), have signed a Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) to develop new technologies for the benefit of the local healthcare industry.

The companies said this collaborative research and development agreement (CRADA) would see MIMOS and KAD developing new technologies to provide wireless and broadband internet access for the betterment of the healthcare industry.

"Kontron and MIMOS will carry out applied research efforts, focusing on developing technology platforms upon which local industries can build products for the world market via Kontron's global footprint," they said in a joint statement.
