Semantic technology in simplified terminology is the software or technology that enables a machine to understand the human user's question or search for information, rather than just providing data to the user.

In short, the technology allows the machine or computer program to become smart or intelligent thus providing the human end user more accurate specific information rather than giving data or information that depend on probabilities (because most systems are incapable of differentiating what is not relevant to the human user).
