Mimos to host 'Knowledge Technology Week'

KUCHING: Mimos, the premier applied research centre in frontier technologies, will be hosting Knowledge Technology Week from July 26 to 30, which will be officially launched by Minister of Housing and Urban Development Datuk Amar Abang Haji Johari Tun Openg on July 28.

Knowledge Technology Week 2010, held in conjunction with National Information and Communications Technology (ICT) month, comprises three conferences, namely, Malaysian Joint Conference on Artificial Intelligence (MJCAI), Semantic Technology and Knowledge Engineering Conference (Stake 2010) and International Conference on Conceptual Structures (ICCS 2010).

The event is jointly organised by

Mimos and the Centre of Excellence in Semantic Technology and Augmented Reality (CoE-STAR), Faculty of Cognitive Science and Faculty of Information Technology of Universiti Malaysia Sarawak (Unimas).

In conjunction with Knowledge Technology Week, Mimos will also be exchanging Memorandum of Agreement documents on semantic technology with International Islamic University Malaysia (represented by Institute of Islamic Banking and Finance) and ePulze Sdn Bhd.

Meanwhile, Unimas will be exchanging a Memorandum of Understanding document with German Research Centre for Artificial Intelligence (DFKI) at University of Kaiserslautern.
