## CCTV, WiFi system installed in Tuaran

TUARAN: The district has been installed with the smart community infrastructure system or iComm that comprises closed-circuit television systems and free WiFi among others.

Science, Technology and Innovation Minister Datuk Seri Wilfred Madius Tangau said thirty iComm poles have been erected in strategic locations including in Kiulu to provide the services including a community communication system application and smart sensors to detect air quality.

“Other than security, the system provides the community with better access to applying science and technology in their daily activities,” he said when launching a science carnival and iComm, Friday.

He also hoped the system will be a catalyst to transform the district as a centre of excellence in the field of science, technology and innovation.

“This will boost the local economy and enhance the living standard of the people,” he added.

iComm is a project under MIMOS Berhad that was launched last year by the Prime Minister.

The system was said to be the first of its kind in the region that brings information and communication technology to the rural community. During the event, Madius also launched a community bulleting that provides information about development projects in the district.
